## **Dan Miller**

First elected to the Legislative Assembly to represent the constituency of North Coast in 1986, he was re-elected in 1991 and 1996. While in Opposition, he was critic for forestry.

Before being elected to the Legislative Assembly, Dan was a Prince Rupert city councillor.
